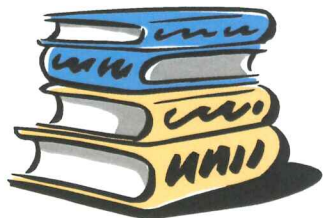
What makes Hiawatha unique?
